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NOTIFICATION

The Kerala State Biodiversity Board invites applications from organisations for financial assistance to programmes that creates awareness about Biodiversity Conservation among the public.

Objectives of the programme must be as follows.

1. Biodiversity Conservation
2. Sustainable utilisation of bio resources
3. Sustainable use of its components and fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of the use of biological resources

Conditions

- Institutions which are involved in activities that fulfil the objectives of Biodiversity Act, 2002 of Government of India and Biodiversity Rules of Kerala such as where Shanthisthal is established or Biodiversity Clubs are run successfully.
- To those BMCs which are successfully fulfilling the objectives of Biodiversity Act 2002 or Biodiversity Rules.
- Organisations including NGOs that have successfully been performing such functions which fulfil the objectives of Kerala State Biodiversity Board, and have work experience for more than three years and are having foolproof system of auditing and ensuring financial propriety.
- A hard copy of a comprehensive report on project/programme execution, audited statement of the expenditure of the expenditure incurred, utilisation certificate, details of participants, programme notice, copy of the certificate issued etc have to be submitted immediately the event is over.

- Awareness programs should be implemented before December 31st.
- Co-operation of the BMCs where the project is implemented should be ensured.
- While project implementation in the institutions the respective District's Project Officers of the Board are required to be invited.
- In the notices, certificates, and the corresponding publication, the logo of the board must be inscribed.

In normal course once the assistance is given, subsequent application for assistance can be made only after two year from the date of receipt of the first assistance.

Applications that do not conform with the above guidelines are not eligible for financial assistance.

Last date of receipt of acceptance of applications – 28th February 2018.
