- Compare ecosystem functionality of artificial, natural, accidental reefs and barren seabed.
- Identify keystone species that contribute to ecosystem stability.
- Provide policy recommendations for design and management of artificial reefs.
- Develop a draft larger DPR for entire Kerala state.
- Evaluate socio-economic and ecological significance of artificial reef deployment.
- Update concerned PBR with final biodiversity data.

B. OUTPUTS AND OUTCOMES

- Comprehensive comparative biodiversity data of artificial, natural, accidental reefs and barren sea beds.
- Insights into the effectiveness of artificial reefs in enhancing marine biodiversity.
- Identification of ecological indicators for monitoring.
- Policy recommendations for artificial reef management.
- Visual documentation of underwater reef systems.

- Final integration into concerned PBR.
