



Kerala State Biodiversity Board announces **Internship scheme** for Post Graduate Students to obtain learning outcome within their curriculum. The knowledge, skills and attitudes acquired through the programme can be applied to foster a deep understanding of biodiversity.

Selection Criteria

Selections will be based on academic performance.

Qualification

Post Graduates (**Botany/ Zoology/ Environmental Science**), having completed/ appeared in the term end exams of second year/4th semester of the Master degree course. The students who have just completed Post Graduation and waiting for admission for higher studies may also be considered for internship.

Period

Short term period From **7 days to 14 days**Long term period From **15 days to 30 days**

Interns not completing the requisite period will not be issued any certificate.

Fees

For short term course, **Rs.1000/-** per student and for long term course, **Rs.2500/-** per student. (*Fee relaxation to **SC/ST** and economically backward (**OEC**) students)

Experience Certificate:

Interns shall present a report of the work as well as study carried out at the end of their internship. A certificate regarding successful completion ofinternship shall be issued

Procedure and conditions for Applicants:

- 1. Applications can be submitted by one student from an institution or a group of maximum 10 nos at a time.
- 2. Interested applicants may apply online and offline only in the address link to be indicated in the website of Kerala State Biodiversity Board.
- 3. Approval for the to internship will be granted based on the number of vacant seats. It is suggested to apply well in advance, preferably two to three months prior to the internship start date
