#### Ecological Sensitive Areas - Kerala State

#### Background

Based on the report and the recommendations of the Expert Committee constituted by the State, the State Government had recommended an area of 9993.7 sq. km. in 123 villages, which includes 9107 sq. km. forest ESA and 886.7 sq. km. non-forest ESA as against 13108 sq. km. in 123 villages given in Dr Kasturirangan Report (HLWG) and the Ministry accepted the recommendation and issued the Draft Notification dated 10.03.2014.

This draft notification was reissued five times without any modification as far as Kerala State is concerned. After the latest notification dated 06th July, 2022, there has been correspondence from the State Government to MoEF&CC regarding reduction in villages and ESA area in the State of Kerala. Besides, there were several requests, complaints, suggestions from the public regarding the demarcation of ESA villages and the regulations put up with it. Government have been considered the representations and complaints raised by public, the pros and cons of imposing restrictions on areas identified as ESA, in a State like Kerala where density of population is high and per capita availability of land is very less.

The State has raised the concerns of public and intimated that some discrepancies are observed in the maps and number of villages in the meeting chaired by Shri A.K. Mehta, Additional Chief Secretary, MoEF&CC on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2018 and assured that the Government would submit its final version along with the areas and maps for the consideration of the Ministry.

After detailed discussions with all stakeholders, the State Government has been taking a consistent stand that ESA in the Western Ghat portion of the State shall be restricted only to Reserve Forests, Protected Areas, World Heritage Sites, etc and excludes the inhabited areas, plantations, rivers, streams, fragmented forests, etc. Accordingly the Directorate of Environment and Climate Change prepared the ESA maps and marked its geo-coordinates by assessing the spatial data obtained from Kerala Forest Department, Survey of India toposheets, cadastral maps and satellite images.

MoEF&CC convened an online meeting of the representatives of Western Ghats States on 05<sup>th</sup> October 2021. In this meeting, the Ministry suggested a new approach of Core and Non-Core ESA in the States. The Additional Chief Secretary (Environment) who attended the meeting affirmed the State's contention on ESA and requested to restrict the ESA in forest areas only. Subsequently, on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> December 2021, the Ministry convened a Chief Minister level meeting at Delhi. Sri. K.N. Balagopal, Hon'ble Minister of Finance

attended the meeting along with Additional Chief Secretary (Environment) and reiterated the State's earlier stand and expressed the State's dissent on Ministry's new proposal.

Concurrently, there are several complaints/grievances from public against the final report submitted by the State about the discrepancies in village boundary, inclusion of private lands, geo-coordinates, etc. especially from Ernakulam, Thiruvananthapuram and Kannur districts. To address the complaints / grievances, the Government constituted a District Level Scrutiny Committee under the Chairmanship of District Collectors to ascertain the ESA of the State by crosschecking the village and forest boundaries by including all the forest areas and by excluding the inhabited areas.

During the visit of the Sri. Sanjay Kumar (IFS Retd) Chairman, Expert Committee on Western Ghats, the Chief Secretary intimated that the final geo-coordinated maps shall submit after rectifying the errors by fine tuning at District level and necessary directions were already issued to District Collectors for the task. It is also submitted that the Committee during its visit perceived the semi-urbanised status and the economic activities pursuing in the ESA villages.

Subsequently, the State Government reworked the ESA documents submitted to the MoEF&CC on 16.06.2018. According to the re-assessment, the total ESA area is now finalized as **8711.98 sq.km in 98 villages**. The number of villages are increased due to the formation of new villages by bifurcating the earlier ESA villages and the ESA area is increased due to inclusion of reserve forests, forest lease areas and modification of village boundaries by the Revenue authorities.
