NOTIFICATION FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS

The Kerala State Biodiversity Board (KSBB) invites proposals from eligible institutions for implementing the project "Empowering Custodian Farmers for Agrobiodiversity Conservation" in the districts of Kottayam, Kollam, Kozhikode, Thiruvananthapuram, Kannur, and Kasargod.

A. PROJECT OVERVIEW

Duration: 1 Year

Objectives:

- 1. To enhance agrobiodiversity in the farm lands of custodian farmers -through bioresources rejuvenation and enrichment of Genetic materials
- 2. Empower custodian farmers as 'Local Genome Saviours' -through survey of genetic materials, training and capacity building
- 3. Documenting the agrobiodiversity of the custodian farmers -through data collection of the crops, breeds, birds and associated flora, fauna and Traditional knowledge
- 4. Organize one District Seed fest and capacity building of 10 farm schools per district
 - -through knowledge sharing and material transfer and insitu onfarm conservation
- 5. Document best practices for policy adoption and wider replication.

B. OUTPUTS AND OUTCOMES

- A minimum of 30 trained custodian farmers with equitable distribution of women per district with enhanced agrobiodiversity and regular Knowledge sharing opportunities with the community
- A minimum of 10 functional farm schools per district with records of farmers visits and meetings
- A district-level Seed Fest and awareness campaign promoting agrobiodiversity
- Comprehensive report of the socio-economic aspects of the farm and

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information on the existing situation of agrobiodiversity of the district

- Policy-level recommendations for sustainable agrobiodiversity management
- DPR for a larger Agrobiodiversity conservation project for the respective district.

C. PROPOSAL CONDITIONS

Budget: Max. ₹7,64,000/- per institution per district (Detailed breakdown included along with application form; *no overhead*

charges permitted).

Who can apply?: Krishi Vigyan Kendras, Regional Agricultural Research Stations, Agriculture Universities, and other R&D Centres.

Submission Limit: Only one proposal per institution will be considered.

District Focus: Proposals must target one of the six specified districts.

D. MANDATORY COMPONENTS

Proposal components to be addressed along with one year time frame:

1. Identification & Documentation of custodian farmers:

- Selection of 30 custodian farmers per district based on existing richness of agrobiodiversity
- Documentation of existing agrobiodiversity and associated traditional knowledge with the selected farmers in stipulated format (KSBB will provide the format, If selected).
- Provision of incentives to farmers for native seed procurement, labor, setting farm school etc.

2. Farm Schools:

• Establishment of 10 farm schools per district (from the selected 30 farmers) as practical learning hubs.

3. Seed Fest & Awareness:

• Organization of one district-level Seed Fest for knowledge sharing and material transfer.

4. Time Frame and Budget breakdown

5. Deliverables

- Comprehensive report (both hard and soft copies) describing all the six outputs and outcomes along with the documented details on the flora, fauna, and traditional practices prevailing in the district.
- Farm Maps with GPS-coordinates
- An Economic Analysis of the Farm
- Expenditure (SE) and Utilization Certificate (UC)
- Photographs of genetic diversity of all varieties and traditional farming methods and Videos showcasing innovative traditional farm practices
